## **REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT POLICIES FOR WOW 2022- 2023**

## POLICIES

**Membership dues of \$25 per student, with a maximum of \$100 per family, will be due upon registration.** This fee includes the opportunity to order a WOW t-shirt, as well as a yearbook picture for each student; parents will be given the digital rights to the photo. This is **NON REFUNDABLE UPON SUBMITTING WOW REGISTRATION.** 

Class changes after registration must go through Stephanie Rappuhn@gmail.com. A \$50 charge will be assessed for any changes requested after May 29, 2022.

Part time students receive (5) funded elective classes each semester. To receive the self pay discounted rate of \$100 for extra elective classes, part time students must take AT LEAST 4 of their 5 OVA classes with WOW.

Full-time virtual students NOT in the hybrid program receive (2) electives. Students in the WOW Hybrid program receive (2) electives and (4) core courses for a total of (6). To receive the self pay discounted rate, full time students must take **AT LEAST 1 of their 2 OVA elective classes with WOW.** 

Exclusively self pay students (no OVA enrollment) may take as many or as few classes as they would like. If a student is registered for 4 electives, additional electives will be \$100 each (plus any registration or supply fees listed).

Self-pay costs (without OVA enrollment) are as follows- membership fee plus:

Onsite elective classes: \$200 per class, plus any supply fees

Offsite elective classes: \$250 per class, plus any facility fees

Core Classes: Math, Social Studies, Science, or ELA through our hybrid program \$350 per class, plus all curriculum

If a parent is not onsite or able to supervise, students MUST have a class each hour they are on the premises. Students MUST remain with their parents to stay onsite without a class. For grades 8-12, students may serve in a volunteer capacity. If a student would like to volunteer, they MUST fill out the volunteer application to be considered. They will be under the supervision of Naomi Powers and expected to follow her instructions for that hour. Volunteer selections will be available for the hours they are needed. Students choosing a volunteer position without applying will NOT be granted their choice.

Invoices will be sent by August 15, 2022 (fall) and January 10, 2023 (winter), with payment or payment arrangements due August 22, 2022 (fall) and January 25, 2023 (winter). Students with unpaid balances, without arrangements, will have their registration held until arrangements or payment is made.

In addition to enrichment and education, one of the goals at WOW is character development, with a focus on kindness. If a student is unable to be kind to another student, teacher, parent, or person on WOW's campus, students will receive 1 warning, and then parents will be called to pick up the student within 30 minutes.

WOW teachers will attempt to engage and positively redirect students in our onsite classes. However, if a student is unable to respectfully participate in class, or is disruptive, there will be 1 warning and then parents will be called to pick up the student within 30 minutes.

If WOW property or materials are destroyed due to malicious misuse, replacement will be the responsibility of the students at fault.

## HYBRID POLICIES

Please be mindful of the fact that after June 16th, 2022, any student dropping from the WOW Hybrid program will be charged a \$600 drop fee.

Only ONE SET of curriculum will be provided by WOW per school year. If the level is later determined to be incorrect, the online and onsite courses will be altered, but the new curriculum purchase will be the family's responsibility.

Parents are considered a primary source of instruction and monitoring, and must agree to uphold this responsibility within the hybrid program. Failure to do so will result in the inability to register for the hybrid option with WOW in subsequent years.

Students with a NM (not mastered) or a failing grade in any course at the end of a semester will be unable to register for the hybrid option with WOW in future years.

Hybrid curriculum is the property of Melissa Redmond, Director of WOW, and any non-consumable items will be returned at the conclusion of the school year, date TBD. Loss or damage will result in reasonable fines or replacement fees.
